Undertaking 1: Implementation of Enacted Laws

- Ensure the implementation by June 2011, of 50% of JLOS sponsored laws enacted during SIP II but are not yet implemented.
- Laws not yet implemented include the following:
- The Trade Secrets Protection Act, 2009
- The Mortgage Act, 2009
- The Domestic Violence Act, 2010
- The Hire Purchase Act, 2009
- The Contracts Act, 2010
- Partnership Act , 2010
- Trademarks Act, 2010
- Computer Misuse Act, 2010
- Electronic Signatures Act, 2010
- Electronic Transactions Act, 2010

Undertaking 2: Monitoring and Evaluation Framework

- Establish clear baselines and set both output and outcome targets for all indicators and implement the approved JLOS Monitoring and Evaluation framework by June 2011.



Undertaking 3:

- Reduce prison congestion by 20% by June 2011, by addressing prison carrying capacity, increasing the disposal rate of cases, increasing the use of community service, strengthening DCCs, setting institutional performance standards and linking the prison information system with Courts, DPP and Police.



Undertaking 4:Anti-corruption Strategy

- Implement the JLOS anti corruption strategy by June 2011.
 - Strategies to achieve this include the completion of the formulation of the anti-corruption strategy by the anti-corruption taskforce.
 - Use of prosecution led investigations for certain cases.



Undertaking 5: Transitional Justice

- A draft policy on transitional justice developed by June 2011 through a consultative process.
 - Commence nation-wide consultations in October, 2010.
 - Engage all stakeholders through regional and national workshops.
 - Final draft report and policy approved by Sector structures by June 2011.



Undertaking 6: Implementation of Audit recommendations

- Develop and implement plan to address audit recommendations arising out of the JLOS 2008/2009 audit report by June 2011.
 - Audit taskforce will work to ensure that the action plan is implemented by June 2011
